

## **Brief Description**

Route already exists, but needs a number of improvements including:

upgrading to an all-weather surface: the surface between Brockham and the fishing lake is potholed due to vehicular traffic, and the next section (heading west) is very muddy after wet weather (quite possibly a reasonable surface underneath);

better signing – eg. at the junction with the A25 there are no signs to direct you onto the shared route alongside the A25, maintenance:

safety improvements by the Tesco-Express entrance (existing signage is of limited use, active measures need to be taken to prevent vehicles blocking the route and intimidating pedestrians and cyclists);

extending the route in towards Dorking centre (currently the route only heads north towards the railway stations and Ashcombe School).

## <u>Users</u> (eg. Schoolchildren, Commuting, Shopping, Leisure)

Schoolchildren (originally established as a Safe Route to School), Commuters heading to/from railway stations, Shoppers accessing Dorking Town Centre, Leisure (various, much used by children as away from traffic)
